To our valued customers:

I am writing this letter to confirm that that RemTec International, Inc. has never purchased, or accepted any Halon 1211 or 1301 from LyonTech Engineering Ltd., a UK based company that has allegedly supplied contaminated Halon to the aviation industry and others in Europe.

Please note that regardless of the source of our used halon, RemTec tests all in-coming halocarbons in our on-site AHRI certified laboratory to determine purity and contaminants before it is processed. We also test 100% of our finished product. Each tank of finished product is separately tested to industry accepted standards including applicable ASTM, ISO and Military Specifications, before it is sold and shipped to any of our customers. Upon request, laboratory certifications are made available at no additional cost for your records.
